

Works returning in 2024: Elizabeth Street at Latrobe Street

Elizabeth Street Sewer Upgrade Project

To cater for growth in Melbourne's CBD, Greater Western Water is constructing a new sewer in Elizabeth Street between Lonsdale and Victoria streets. The project is being delivered for Greater Western Water by Rob Carr Pty Ltd.

What we are doing and when

Currently all work sites along Elizabeth Street have been temporarily shut down for the holiday period and the northbound lane has fully reopened. Steel road plates have been installed over the shafts to ensure the road is safe to use.

Starting from **Thursday 11 January 2024**, we will re-establish part of work site E3 on Elizabeth Street north of La Trobe Street. We will also be undertaking Non-Destructive Digging (NDD) works within the intersection at night. Refer to the map overleaf.

What to expect at site E3 – Elizabeth Street north of La Trobe Street

- Work will start on **Thursday 11 January 2024** and take place **between 7am and 6pm Monday to Thursday**, and **7am to 4pm on Saturdays**.
- The northbound traffic lanes along Elizabeth Street will be closed between Latrobe Street and A'Beckett Street.
- This work site will remain until the **end of March 2024**, when works are expected to be complete.
- From **Tuesday 23 January 2024**, night works will take place between **9pm and 5am Monday to Thursday** in conjunction with the daytime works. These night works are expected to be complete by **early February 2024**.
- The works will include excavation, tunnelling, asphaltting and truck/crane operations.
- This work will not impact your sewerage or water supplies.

What to expect at the Elizabeth Street and La Trobe Street intersection

- Non-Destructive Digging (NDD) works will start on **Monday 15 January 2024** and are expected to be complete **Tuesday 23 January 2024**. These works will only take place at night, **between 9pm and 5am Monday to Thursday**.
- The works will include road sawing, excavation and truck operations.
- Road sawing will generate a moderate amount of noise, and is expected to be completed during the first night of NDD works.
- This work will not impact your sewerage or water supplies.



Why are night works required?

We make every effort to complete works during the day wherever possible, however some activities must be completed at night. Some of these construction activities need to happen when traffic volumes are lower, and some tunnelling activities need to continue 24/7.
